# HB 3 - Census Block

- ▶ 12 digit field concatenated out of several other fields
  - ▶ State ID - 2 digits
  - ▶ County ID - 3 digits
  - ▶ Census Tract - 6 digits
  - ▶ Block Group - 1 digit
- ▶ Not reported if student is Homeless
- ▶ Not reported if student's ADA code is 0
- ▶ Student resides in more than one attendance zone (dual custody situation)
  - ▶ Use address of parent in your attendance zone
  - ▶ If neither parent resides in your attendance zone, campus chooses address to use
- ▶ Student Census Block Group Roster Report at Campus & LEA level

# DYSLEXIA Reporting

- ▶ **DYSLEXIA-SERVICES-CODE** now reported to indicate the type of dyslexia or related services student received at any time during the school year
  - ▶ 00 - Does not receive services for dyslexia or a related disorder
  - ▶ 01 - Receiving services for dyslexia or a related disorder with an individualized education program developed for the student under Section 29.005; or a plan developed for the student under Section 504, Rehabilitation Act of 1973
  - ▶ 02 - Receiving instruction that meets applicable dyslexia program criteria established by the State Board of Education; and is provided by a person with specific training in providing that instruction.
  - ▶ 03 - The student is permitted, on the basis of having dyslexia or a related disorder, to sue modifications in the classroom or accommodations in the administration of assessment instruments under Section 39.023

# GIFTED and TALENTED PROGRAM CODE

- ▶ HB 3 requires LEAs to annually certify that the LEA has established a program for gifted and talented student as required by TED §29.124
- ▶ Funding can be reduced if not reported as required
- ▶ GIFTED-TALENTED-PROGRAM-CODE
  - ▶ 00 - Does not provide a program for gifted and talented students
  - ▶ 01 - PULL OUT - Part-time services in classroom other than regular classroom or takes the place of regular schedule with training teacher
  - ▶ 02 - PUSH IN - Gifted/talented trained teacher provides occasional services to a student while the student in in regular classroom
  - ▶ 03 - FULL-TIME GIFTED - Student receives majority of their core subjects form G/T trained teacher with peers identified as G/T
  - ▶ 04 - FULL-TIME INCLUSION - Student receives majority of their core subjects form G/T trained teacher but classes may include peers not identified as G/T
  - ▶ 05 - Special day school - Special school which is administratively separate from regular schools and is organized to served G/T students with G/T trained teachers

# EXPANDED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES

- ▶ ELOs offered at each campus will be reported
- ▶ Sec. 48.009. REQUIRED PEIMS REPORTING.
- ▶ [~~(a-1)~~] The commissioner by rule shall require each school district and open-enrollment charter school to report through the Public Education Information Management System information regarding:
  - ▶ [~~(1)~~] the availability of expanded learning opportunities as described by Section 33.252 at each campus; [~~and~~]
  - ▶ [~~(2)~~] ~~the number of students participating in each of the categories of expanded learning opportunities listed under~~
- ▶ ~~Section 33.252(b).~~

# LEAVER-REASON-CODE ADDITIONS

- ▶ Two new leaver reason codes added to C162 code table
  - ▶ **08 - Pregnancy** - Student (male or female) withdrew from/left school because of pregnancy
  - ▶ **20 - Medical injury** - Student has suffered a condition, injury, or illness that requires substantial medical care and leaves the student unable to attend school and assigned to a medical or residential treatment facility
- ▶ Documentation supporting Leaver code 60 - Homeschooled - must state the date home schooling began (past tense). Intent to home school starting in the future IS NOT acceptable
